ANNOUNCING THE 2011 ANNUAL MARY S. CERNEY MEMORIAL AWARD

*Given by the Society for Personality Assessment
for the Outstanding Student Paper on Personality Assessment*

Deadline: July 1, 2010

The Society for Personality Assessment is now accepting manuscripts for the annual **Mary S. Cerney Award**, given to the best student paper (a paper generated sometime over the past year) dealing with some aspect of personality assessment. The paper can be based on either quantitative or qualitative research, or could be theoretical in focus. Research studies should be well designed. The format should be APA journal article style.

Award: The winning entrant is expected to be present at the 2011 Annual Meeting of the Society for Personality Assessment in Boston, MA, March 9-13, 2011, to accept the award. The recipient will receive an award certificate, one night's lodging at the Annual Meeting, up to \$300 to defray travel expenses, and will have the registration fee for the meeting waived.

Eligibility: Students in psychology or related disciplines. Papers based on doctoral dissertations are eligible if the research was completed prior to the granting of a doctoral degree and submitted within a year of completing the degree.

Submission: Submit a paper as a journal-style manuscript. For co-authored submissions, the student must be the first author. Please do not submit an entire dissertation or thesis. Submit to: Society for Personality Assessment, 6109H Arlington Boulevard, Falls Church, VA 22044.
