**Full-Time Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Psychological Assessment

**The Psychology Training Program of Massachusetts General Hospital invites applications for a full-time, one year, Post-Doctoral Fellowship in adult psychological assessment. This position has a primary emphasis on providing psychological assessment services but also includes training in assessment based research and psychotherapy. Applicants who graduated with a PhD or PsyD from an APA-accredited program are eligible to apply for this position that begins on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010. The position offers extensive supervised experience conducting comprehensive psychological and neuropsychological assessments on a wide range of complex adult cases. Research involves coordinating one of the labs ongoing projects in test development, scale validation, and psychotherapy outcome. Research involvement typically leads to secondary authorship and conference presentations. Fellows also receive supervised psychotherapy training. Applicants should send a letter of interest, graduate school transcripts, curriculum vitae, three letters of reference, two psychological assessment reports and any relevant research papers to Mark A.
